

# Visitor Guidelines

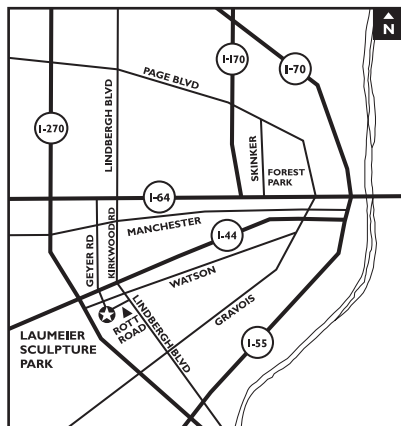
**Climbing**  
We ask for your cooperation in protecting our works of art, as well as your safety, by not climbing on any sculptures. Even though our artwork is outdoors and subject to the elements, physical contact can still do irreparable damage to the surfaces of the works. Part of our mission is to preserve these works for future generations.

**Pets**  
Pets are welcome visitors at Laumeier Sculpture Park in all outdoor areas, but they must be leashed at all times.

**Photography**  
To protect the artwork on display and assure copyright protections to the artists we present, no photography or videography is allowed inside the Museum Galleries. Due to copyright restrictions, visitor safety and access concerns, no commercial photography or videography is allowed on Laumeier property without permission. 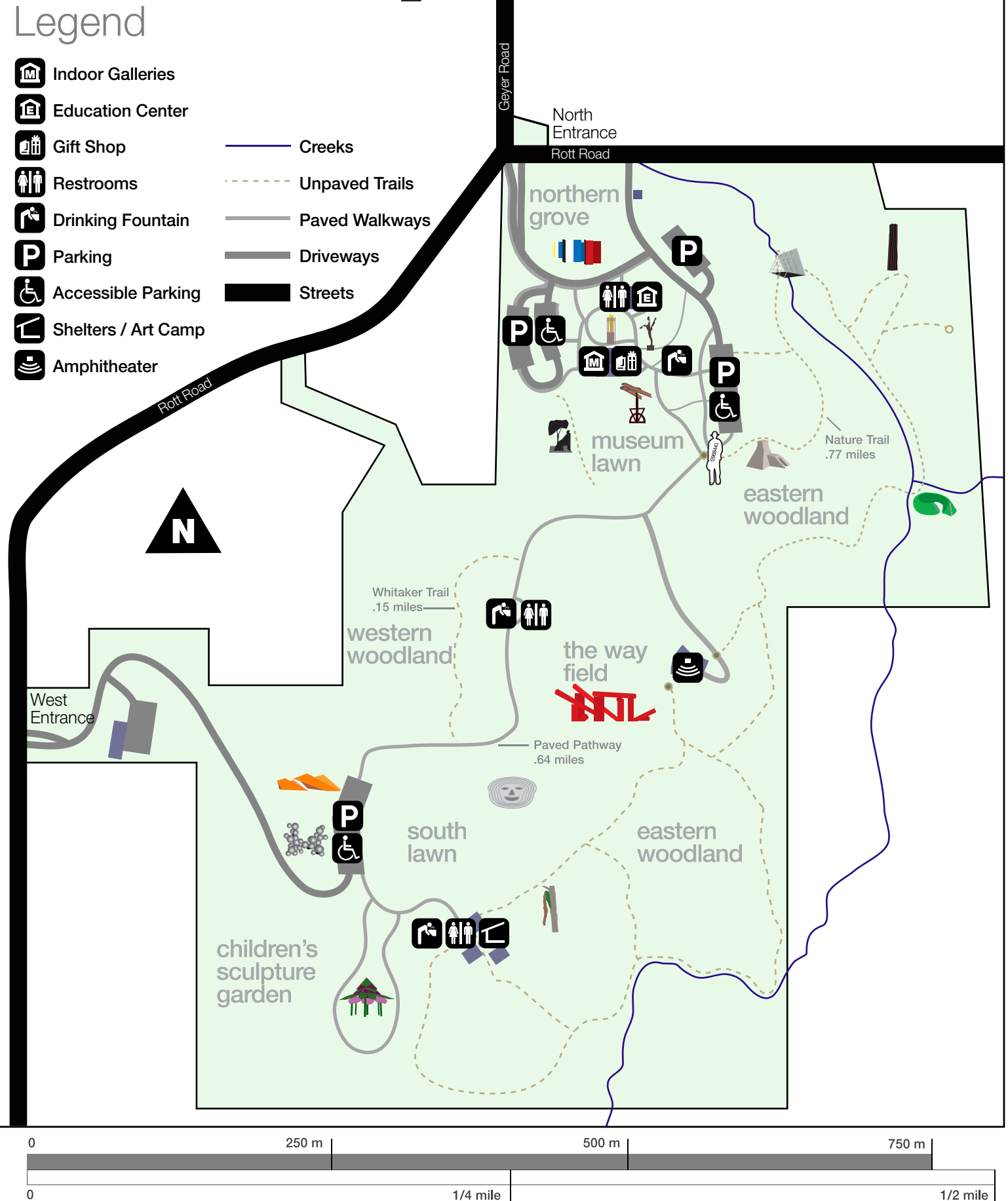
