

## Artist Submissions

Laumeier Sculpture Park, a private / public partnership non-profit arts organization, organizes exhibitions, commissions new work and occasionally presents long-term loans with a focus on global, contemporary sculpture.

Artists whose works are presented at Laumeier are invited by the Director and Curatorial Staff and considered within the context of Laumeier's activities over the past 30 years and in dialogue with global contemporary artistic practice. We host three rotating indoor exhibition cycles per year, with additional loans and commissions that enter into the unique physical space of Laumeier Sculpture Park and its permanent collection of large-scale sculpture and supporting works in other media.

Staff will periodically review submissions of art work for consideration in our schedule.

No telephone calls for artist interviews or walk-in requests will be accepted; do not submit work via e-mail.

Proposals and Submissions must include each of the following:

- Digital imagery on CD or DVD, images must be in a JPEG or TIFF format and be no larger than 8x10" or 300 dpi. The CD or DVD must be labeled with your name, current contact information and date.

At the top of each of the following documents include your name and current contact information: address, phone number and email address.

- A printed image list to correspond with the digital imagery presented on CD or DVD. Please include relevant information regarding the images: title, date of completion, materials and dimensions. Other information may be included as needed.
- A one page artist's statement and / or project description. Artists may direct staff to a website where this material is available.
- A current resume
- Maximum of two pieces of support material: reviews, catalogs, exhibition cards or other publications

Submissions must adhere to the above criteria to be eligible for review.

If you would like your submitted materials returned, you must enclose a self-addressed, pre-post marked envelope. Proposals and submissions are reviewed periodically and will be returned within three months upon receipt.
